\* National Grange was founded on Dec. 4, 1867

\* New Hampshire State Grange was founded on Dec. 23, 1873

\* Seven Founders of the Order:

Oliver Hudson Kelley: first secretary of the National Grange, he had a farm located in Itasca, Minnesota. He was the last of the Seven Founders to pass away. He is known as the "Father of the Grange".

William Saunders: first Master of the National Grange

John Thompson: first Lecturer of the National Grange, he was born in NH

William Ireland: first Treasurer of the National Grange

Rev. Aaron B. Grosh: first Chaplain of the National Grange

Caroline Hall: Oliver Hudson Kelley's niece and was named an Honorary Founder in 1892. She was the first Ceres of the National Grange. She was also the first Lady Assistant Steward of the National Grange.

\* Fredonia Grange in New York was the first working Subordinate Grange

\* Gilman Grange No. 1, in Exeter, NH was the first Grange Organized in the State of NH

\* The Grange Motto is: "In essentials unity, in non-essentials liberty, in all things charity."

\* The Youth Slogan is: "I'd be delighted".

· Junior – Dark Red

· Subordinate – National Blue

· Pomona – Dark Green

· State – Pink

· National – Gold

· Youth -Green

\* GROW Club – group for past royalty. GROW stands for Go Right On Working
